Todd-Wadena Electric Cooperative Graduating Senior Scholarship Requirements & Procedures

1. Description

 Todd-Wadena Electric Cooperative (TWEC) will award up to four (4) \$1,000 scholarships to 2026 graduating high school seniors for their first year as a (freshman) college student.

2. Criteria

- Complete and sign the application.
- Applicant must be a high school senior graduating in Spring of 2026.
- Applicant's parents or legal guardians must be a Todd-Wadena Electric Cooperative member whose <u>primary</u> residence receives electricity from TWEC.
- Average GPA of at least 2.0 or better during grade 9 through first half of grade 12.
- Be accepted by an accredited two or fouryear college/university, or a vocationaltechnical school.
- Involved in 2 different extra-curricular activities (school, employment, community), during high school.

3. Award Procedure

- Applications will be reviewed by a review panel.
- Winners will be notified by April, and attendance is requested of scholarship winners to attend the Annual Meeting on Thursday, April 16, 2026.
- Scholarships will be awarded on a one-time basis and will not be renewable.
- The student must attend a post-secondary school during the 2026-2027 academic year to receive the funds.
- The scholarship check will be mailed directly to the Financial Aid Office of the school of choice. The full amount of the scholarship will be mailed during the last week of September.

- If a recipient withdraws from school or elects to attend a non-accredited school after receiving a scholarship, the scholarship will be terminated and any refunds from the school will go to TWFC.
- Scholarships will be awarded without regard to race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, gender, or disability. Children or grandchildren of current TWEC employees or directors are ineligible.

4. When to Apply
