Power Up Adult Scholarship Requirements & Procedures

Todd-Wadena Electric Cooperative will award up to two (2) \$1,000 Power Up Adult Scholarship to adult students who are headed to college for the first time, returning to complete an interrupted education, or looking to return to college to improve their career opportunities.

1. Criteria

- The applicant must be a U.S. Citizen.
- The application must be typed for legibility.
- The applicant must be 18 years of age or older.
- The applicant must have an active Todd-Wadena Electric Cooperative account with TWEC service for at least six months prior to the application deadline.
- The applicant or their spouse must be an active member and in good standing with Todd-Wadena Electric Cooperative
- The applicant's <u>primary</u> residence must be served by TWEC.

2. Award Procedure

- All applications will be reviewed by a review committee.
- The applicant cannot previously have won a scholarship from TWEC.
- Winner will be notified by April and attendance is requested of scholarship winners to attend the Annual Meeting on Thursday, April 16, 2026.
- Scholarships will be awarded on a one-time basis and will not be renewable.
- The scholarship check will be mailed to the Financial Aid Office of the institution you will be attending. The check will be made out in the name of the scholarship recipient and the institution. The full amount of the

- scholarship will be mailed during the last week of September.
- If a recipient withdraws from school or elects to attend a non-accredited school after receiving a scholarship, the scholarship will be terminated and any refunds from the school will go to TWEC.
- Scholarships will be awarded without regard to race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, gender, or disability. TWEC employees, directors, children or grandchildren of TWEC employees or directors are ineligible to apply.

3. When to Apply
